

MAKITA SERVICE INFORMATION

- Part 24:** A screw used to secure the lower housing.
- Part 25:** A screw used to secure the lower housing.
- Part 26:** A small rectangular component, possibly a battery or sensor, which is attached to the side of the lower housing.
